

WHAT IS MDT?

MEASUREMENT DECISION THEORY

We use MDT to calculate your MOCA Minute® performance based on the question difficulty and your pattern of responses for your most recent 120 questions. Your MOCA Minute performance is not a percent correct.

MDT values run from zero to one, with one being the highest. If you answer 120 MOCA Minute questions each year by 11:59 p.m. EST on Dec. 31 and maintain an MDT value of ≥ 0.10 , you're meeting the standard.

WHEN YOU DON'T ANSWER YOUR QUESTIONS

Any MOCA Minute questions you don't answer by 11:59 p.m. EST on Dec. 31 will count as incorrect. This will lower your performance. You can only answer 30 MOCA Minute questions each day, so please allow yourself enough time.

WHEN YOU ANSWER QUESTIONS INCORRECTLY

Your MDT value goes down, which lowers your performance.



WHEN YOU ANSWER QUESTIONS CORRECTLY

Your MDT value goes up and your performance is raised.
